Course Overview

This qualification helps provide students with the skills to assist educational professionals and play an active role in helping young people. Students will learn how to assist school students in the classroom and support teachers with education-based activities.

People wanting to start a career assisting school-aged children and supporting teachers in the classroom.

Delivery mode



On campus – this course has a full-time study component which includes 2 days a week face to face classroom sessions, online activities, work placement (120 hours) and self-directed learning.



Online – online delivery through comprehensive learning management platform (First Aid and 120 hour work placement must be completed face to face).

Course duration

Between 9 and 12 months. This course has a full time study component which includes 2 days a week face to face classroom sessions, online activities, placement and self-directed learning.

Language, Literacy and Numeracy assistance

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

Applicants may be awarded full or partial qualifications based on their RPL assessment. If you have previous qualifications, work or life experiences be sure to mention them in your pre-enrolment interview.
