

# Charter of Commitment to Child Safety

*Cire Services is committed to creating a child safe organisation where all children and young people are safe and feel safe.*

*Cire Services have a greater focus on safety for those children and young people who are considered more at risk to abuse and neglect.*

*Cire Services actively supports and facilitates participation and inclusion of Aboriginal children, children from culturally and/or linguistically diverse backgrounds (CALD), those who are unable to live at home, children with a disability and/or children from sexuality and gender diverse groups (LGBTQIA+).*

- *We have a commitment to managing both **physical and online environments** to keep children and young people safe through **governance, systems and processes**. This statement provides the framework for the organisational approach to complying with best practice by aligning with **Victorian** Child Safe Standards in conjunction with the guiding National Principles for Child Safety*
- *We have a zero tolerance to abuse, racism, and bullying*
- *We have an explicit commitment to the cultural safety of Aboriginal children*
