Course Overview

This course is designed to give students the skills and knowledge necessary to assist a person requiring first aid until medical assistance arrives. If you are a first aid officer, it is mandatory that your qualification is updated every three years.

Who should enrol?

Anyone working in training, teaching or have charge of children, teenagers, the elderly, disabled or working as an industry First Aid Officer may require a First Aid Certificate.

The Victorian Code of Practice for First Aid in the Workplace suggests that first aid officers update their certificates regularly.

Delivery mode

Duration - 6 hours

- Individual training: regular courses available in the evenings at our Lilydale office
- Group training: this training is available on site for organisations, community groups and schools either on location or at a Cire Training site (where available)
