Course Overview

This diploma is the minimum qualification required to direct or manage children's services centre-based care. Students learn how to plan, implement and manage programs in early childhood services and be responsible for supervising a team of staff.

Entry Requirements

Students must have completed a Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC30113 or CHC30121).

Language, Literacy and Numeracy assistance

Students enrolling in a Cire Training accredited course will be required to undertake a Literacy, Language and Numeracy assessment. This is to ensure that you have the required skills to complete the course successfully. Students who need assistance will be offered support through a class or individual support program.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

You may be eligible to apply for RPL if you have evidence of knowledge and skills achieved that meet the competency requirements of your chosen qualification. Applicants may be awarded full or partial qualifications based on their RPL assessment. If you have previous qualifications, work or life experiences be sure to mention them in your pre-enrolment interview.
