Course overview

Graduates gain the skills required to responsibly serve and sell alcoholic beverages in licensed venues. In Victoria, it is mandatory to complete the Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor Regulation (VCGLR) course if you sell or serve alcohol.

Who should enrol?

Anyone working in a licensed venue or bottle shop, managers of establishments or, if you are applying for a liquor licence.

Duration and study mode

Duration - 4 hours

- Individual training: regular courses available in the evenings at our Lilydale office
- Group training: this training is available on site for organisations, community groups and schools either on location or at a Cire Training site (where available)
